Heart Attack Warning Signs from the American Heart Association

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense—the "movie heart attack," where no one doubts what's happening. But most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain or discomfort. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Here are signs that can mean a heart attack is happening:

- **Chest discomfort.** Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.
- **Discomfort in other areas of the upper body.** Symptoms can include pain or discomfort in one or both arms, the back, neck, jaw or stomach.
- **Shortness of breath** may occur with or without chest discomfort.
- **Other signs** may include breaking out in a cold sweat, nausea or lightheadedness.

If you are experiencing unexplained symptoms, seek medical care for further evaluation. If you think you are having a heart attack, do not delay. Call for emergency help (911 in most areas). Quick treatment of a heart attack is very important to reduce the amount of damage to your heart.

In the heart of a man, the signs above warn the individual to call 911 for immediate medical attention. However in **Iraq: the heart of the beast**, things are just the opposite. **BECAUSE OF 911**, the beast is currently experiencing symptoms of a heart attack, and therefore requires immediate heart surgery.

The heart has TWO main blood vessels that circulate the flow of blood throughout the body: the Pulmonary Artery and the Pulmonary Vein and FOUR blood filled chambers. **Iraq is the heart of the beast**, and has TWO main rivers: the Tigris and the Euphrates. Soon after 11/07/06, Iraq will undergo Major heart surgery, and it's FOUR parts: Kurdistan, Sunni, Shia, and the International Green Zone will be separated to prevent a major heart attack (civil war in Iraq) occurring in the beast.
